UNION JURISDICTIONS

UNION JURISDICTIONS ARE IN EFFECT AT THE BOSTON CONVENTION CENTER PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING SUMMARY OF WHEN LABOR RULES APPLY THESE RULES MAY IMPACT YOU AS A VENDOR:

(1) If You Require Mechanized Equipment To Move Your Items:

Work rules require that the union labor supervised by Demers Expo off-load all equipment and display material from commercial carriers/common carriers or van lines. The use of fork trucks, pallet jacks (electric and/or hydraulic),lift gates, and/or any mechanized material handing apparatus are permitted only by the union labor managed by the show's general contractor (Demers Exposition).

Exhibitors are allowed to perform their own material handling, provided they meet all of the following criteria:Freight is hand carried, transported on (non-mechanized hand-operated) dollies, hand trucks, or push carts.

- Personnel performing the work must be bonafide, full-time company employee(s) of the exhibiting company.
- They must be off-loading from a company owned, rental, or vehicle owned by personnel of the exhibiting company. All trucks and trailers, including co-owned or rental vehicles, with a <u>cargo area of 24' or larger</u> in length must be off-loaded and loaded by union labor managed by the show's general contractor (Demers Exposition).

The use of fork trucks, pallet jacks, lift gates or any other mechanical equipment is not permitted by anyone other than union labor.

The use of a loading a dock will required your equipment be unloaded and reloaded by union labor.

(2) If You Require Assistance To Set Your Booth:

Exhibitors are permitted to perform the work to set your booth, provided they meet all of the following criteria:

- The employees performing work must be full-time employees of the Exhibiting Company.
- Employment ID to verify full time employment must be produced if requested.
- Assistance needed in addition to your full-time employees must be ordered union labor secured through Demers Exposition.

*Notice to Exhibitors Regarding use of Exhibitor Appointed Contractors (EAC):

EACs are permitted to supervise the exhibitor's booth set-up and dismantle labor, but employees of the EAC may not perform the actual work to set the booth. Work can only be performed by exhibiting company's full-time employees or union labor secured through Demers Exposition.
